RECTOR OF UNIVERSITAS NEGERI PADANG

- Considering : a. that to build the image of Universitas Negeri Padang students who behave professionally and reliably, it is necessary to establish a Code of Ethics for UNP Students;
- b. that in connection with the point “a” above, it is necessary to issue a Rector’s Decree.
- Recalling : 1. Law No.20 of 2003 concerning National Education;
2. Government Regulation No.60 of 1990 concerning Higher Education;
3. Decree of Minister of Education and Culture of Republic of Indonesia No.222/0/2000 concerning the UNP Statute;
4. Decree of Minister of Education and Culture of Republic of Indonesia No. 093/0/2004, concerning OTK UNP;
- Noticing : Executive Board Assembly Meeting of Universitas Negeri Padang, on 9th, September 2004.

HAS DECIDED

Enacting

- First** : Students' Code of Ethic of Universitas Negeri Padang as follows;
1. UNP students are citizens who have devotion to God Almighty and are highly educated. They are aware that their performance and professional activities have an essential effect and become benchmarks for the wider community.

2. UNP students have an attachment and are loyal to implementing applicable laws and regulations, especially in higher education.
3. UNP students uphold scientific truth and honesty and avoid actions that violate the scientific community's norms, such as plagiarism, falsification of data, and so on.
4. UNP Students implement learning activities with passion against the knowledge that they do, further support the improvement and development of abilities and knowledge,
5. UNP students, as community members honored with high self-esteem, always refrain from misconduct and not abuse the institution of UNP for the Personal benefit
6. UNP students in carrying out their activities for the community, behave as fully trusted professionals, prioritize the interests of the nation and state, and always uphold the honor and good name of UNP
7. UNP students must have a high commitment to time.
8. UNP students must dress politely and neatly, not wearing sandals and shorts or trousers in the campus area.
9. UNP students are prohibited from gambling, drinking liquor, drugs in all forms on campus.
10. UNP students are prohibited from smoking, eating, drinking, and turning on cellphones in class.
11. Students are forbidden to interfere with learning activities at UNP, either when learning in the classroom and outside the classroom during the hours of lecture.
12. UNP students are prohibited from speeding in the campus area.
13. UNP students are strictly prohibited from committing acts of extortion, bribery, sexual harassment, and forgery of any kind.
14. UNP students are prohibited from carrying firearms and sharp weapons in the classroom and on campus
15. UNP students use and maintain all facilities on the UNP

campus properly, correctly, and responsibly

16. UNP students are strictly prohibited from bringing existing facilities on campus outside of the UNP campus except with special permission.
17. If UNP students remove or damage existing campus facilities, they must replace them under the agreement with the UNP campus supervisor.
18. UNP Residents must maintain cleanliness in the campus area, lecture rooms, workshops/labor/studio, maintain computers, libraries, discussion rooms and cafeterias, and other facilities.

Second : Students who violate the Students' Code of Ethic of Universitas Negeri Padang will be subject to the following sanctions:

1. The first penalty is in the form of a warning in oral or written. The written warning is passed to students' parents or guardians.
2. The second penalty is in the form of academic suspension;
3. The third penalty is disrespectfully expelled from UNP.
